1. With a view to spotting out Statistical talent at an early stage, C.R. Rao AIMSCS, takes pleasure in organizing: “**THE SEVENTH STATISTICS OLYMPIAD 2015**”, a talent search competition in Mathematics with an aptitude for numbers and data handling for students of High Schools and Junior Colleges in Telangana and Andhra Pradesh states. The competition will be in the form of a written examination of three hours duration. It will be held on **Sunday the 14th June 2015 between 09:00 a.m and 12:00 noon** at the following centres

2. **In view of the huge response it is decided to conduct the Statistics Olympiad 2015 for the students who meet the following eligibility criteria**

Students who have qualified in Regional Mathematical Olympiad (RMO) 2014
(List is available at <http://crraoaimscs.org>)

OR

Students who have secured grade A+ or **$\geq 90\%$ marks in Mathematics** in Class IX or X or Class XI of CBSE/ICSE(or Intermediate 1st year or equivalent) or class XII of CBSE/ICSE or Intermediate 2nd Year studied during 2014-15

3. The competition is conducted at Two Levels:
 - a) **Junior Level:** Students who completed Class IX or X during 2014-15.
 - b) **Senior Level:** Students who completed Class XI of CBSE/ICSE(or Intermediate 1st year or equivalent) or class XII of CBSE/ICSE or Intermediate 2nd Year during 2014-15.
4. In each level top 3 students will be given CR Rao and C Bhargavi Rao Prizes of Rs. 5000, Rs. 3000 and Rs. 2000. Top 10 students in each level will be awarded a merit certificate on 29th June 2015 during Ninth Statistics Day celebrations at C R Rao AIMSCS, Hyderabad.

5. SCOPE OF THE TEST: Since the test is in the nature of a talent competition, no special knowledge of any particular syllabus is required. The test questions would not be primarily of any syllabus oriented but of a nature requiring insight, critical approach, logical thinking, the power of application of knowledge in solving problems and a general mathematical maturity and statistics appropriate at that level.
6. The question papers will be in English. Answer scripts will be supplied at the centres. Candidates will have to bring their own pen and instruments box etc. Calculators/Mobile Phones/Electronic Gadgets are not allowed. *There will be 10 questions descriptive in nature and all the questions are to be answered.*
7. Interested candidates are requested to apply by filling the online registration form available in our website <http://www.crraoaimscs.org> on or before 06th June 2015 mid night.

Note: Candidate has to bring 2 (two) copies of the admit card photograph affixed, Xerox copy of the school identity card and Xerox copy of the marks memo displaying the marks obtained in the class studied during the academic year 2014-15.
